This year saw the return of our War of the Roses festival - created by Mark, Jane, and Gemma from our Under 12s team. What started as a small idea to give our Under 11s more game time has blossomed into a full-blown day of rugby. In our first year of the festival in 2023, we hosted 6 Northwest teams and 5 Yorkshire teams totaling 100 girls. This year, the event grew massively, with some teams even having enough for two squads, totaling 225 girls playing rugby across the day.

Girls Rugby is growing every year and to be able to have 8 pitches hosting U12s girls matches across the day was amazing to see, with smiles all round and teams getting involved in the activities across the day.

The Under 15s set the tone with a dominant 50-0 victory over Greetland, igniting a day of thrilling rugby.

We also had 16 local stalls come down to add a carnival feel to the day as well as an amazing BBQ hosted by Crosfields U11s raising money for their team.

Some stats from the day include 60 games played with 237 tries scored totalling 948 points!
